





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NAPC's primary care home model



Primary care home is an approach to strengthening and redesigning primary care.

The model brings together a range of health and social care professionals as a complete care community – from GP surgeries, community, mental health and acute trusts, social care and the voluntary sector – to focus on local population needs and provide care closer to patients' homes.



It is an established primary care network – a central plank of the new NHS Long Term Plan providing care to a registered population of 30-50,000.

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How Does Primary Care Nursing Compare between the United Kingdom and the United States?

United Kingdom

- Consistent role for nurses in primary care
- Nursing leadership and oversight
- Leadership development opportunities

United States

- Decline of nurses in primary care until the last 5-10 years
- Newly developing role of 'Care Manager' in primary care – limited leadership available
- Certifications available in Ambulatory Nursing and Care Management
