Significant gains in change and improvement culture and work relationships with no significant increase in chaos noted

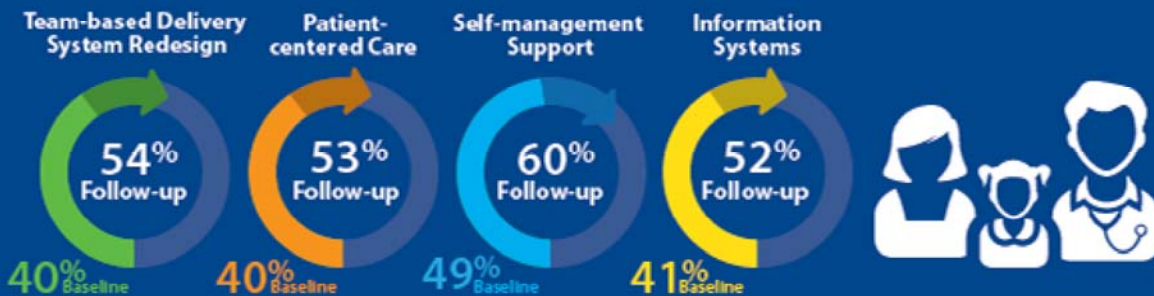
